The Inescapable Question

It Palm Sunday! Hosanna in the highest!

Jesus rode a donkey into Jerusalem

Zecheriah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O Daughter of Zion! Shout, Daughter of Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation, gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. NIV

In the last 2 weeks of His earthly life, Jesus did the following:

- * Healed blind Bartimaeus
- * He brought salvation to Zacchaeus the tax collector
- * Jesus Raised Lazarus from the dead
- * He rode on a donkey into Jerusalem
- * Cleansed the Temple & Cursed the fig tree
- * Challenged the authority of religious leaders
- * Had dinner with Mary & Martha & Lazarus, Mary poured perfume on his feet & wiped them with her hair.
- * Taught about the widow who gave 2 coins; about faith that can move mountains; parable of the wicked tenants who killed the son;
- * He helped Peter pay taxes
- * Preached the Olivet Discourse 3 main points:
 - 1. The End is near 2. Jesus will return 3. Be ready.
- * Passover the Lord's Supper
- * Jesus washed the disciple's feet

He did all this & more knowing what was coming.

See Matthew 27:15-26

The question remains: What shall we do with Jesus?

What did the others do?

- 1. Judas betrayed Jesus for money
- 2. The Chief Priests, Elders, and teachers of the law They captured and killed Jesus; falsely accused Him, stirred up the crowd and shouted crucify Him
- 3. The crowd Followed the leaders; did what they were told; loved Jesus on Sunday when they thought He would overthrow Rome, but they turned on Him on Friday.
- The soldiers excitedly obeyed orders; mocked and beat Jesus and crucified Him.
- 5. The wife of Pilate Have nothing to do with Jesus
- 6. Governor Pontius Pilate Knew Jesus was innocent; tried 3 times to free Jesus; was afraid of a riot and the loss of his job and life; washed his hands thinking it would relieve him of the responsibility; released Barabbas and had Jesus crucified.
- 7. The Centurion Said Jesus was the Son of God

The Inescapable Question

Your eternal destiny is at stake!

What will you do with Jesus?

- Betray Him? Ignore Him? Plot against Him? Turn away when things are difficult? Follow the crowd?
- Believe Jesus is who He says He is.
- Trust Him and allow Him to change your hearts.
