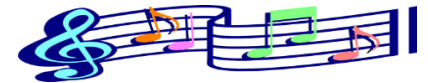

## Today's Message The Breath of God

### Where did the Bible come from?

The 66 books of the Bible were written by 40 men +/- of various backgrounds over a period of 1500 years. Isaiah was a prophet, Ezra was a priest, Matthew was a tax-collector, John was a fisherman, Paul was a tentmaker, Moses was a shepherd, Luke was a physician, James & Jude were the brothers of Jesus. Yet the Bible does not contradict itself and does not contain any errors.

**How is this possible?** Because God is The Source  
See 2 Timothy 3:16-17 & 2 Peter 1:20-21

**How could the disciples remember what Jesus said?**  
See John 14:25-26 & John 16:12-14

**What is the benefit of God's word?**  
teaching, rebuking, correcting, training in righteousness

For us to be thoroughly equipped for every good work

2. It is "The word of God" – given by divine inspiration.
